### What is the Tim Hortons Peachbud 10K School Challenge?

The Tim Hortons Peachbud 10K School Challenge is a new initiative to encourage all secondary schools in West Niagara to host their own race in support of our local hospital. The length of the race would be selected by the school (ie: 100m, 800m, etc) and would occur on school property (ie: around the school's running track). Students will have the opportunity to donate toonies and spare change to the WLMH Foundation's Project X-ray campaign immediately prior to the race. A Foundation representative will be available on the day of the event to help oversee race activities.

### What is the Peachbud Raffle?

The Tim Hortons Peachbud 10K committee of the West Lincoln Memorial Hospital Foundation is raffling off a Wii & Wii Fit to raise funds for our local community hospital! During the week leading up to the race, a member of the Peachbud 10K Race committee and a couple of students would be in charge of setting up a booth and selling tickets. Here are a few additional details:

- The winning tickets will be drawn at the Tim Hortons Peachbud 10K signature race on Tuesday, June 30, 2009.
